Footnotes

HUNTERWOOD POINT showed reserve and awaited options into the turn, responded to urging near the quarter pole, challenged between rivals at top of stretch, split foes at the eighth pole and strided away in final sixteenth. BRAZOS EGO saved ground while setting the pace, unable to fend off rallying foe. FAREWELL BROADWAY vied from the two path all the way. JUNGLE RAJ tucked behind early pacesetters to save ground and finished willingly. LOUIE TRE lacked a needed rally to improve placing after giving chase from between rivals. BIG MISSION trekked five wide through the turn and lacked a closing bid. HOT FIRE took a three path route. CATTLE BARON trekked widest of all, losing ground through the turn to foes. FRENZO was of little impact to outcome from a back rated stance.
