WILD WILLIAM well positioned along inside from outset, came off rail three wide into lane, responded to steady urging in drive, up in final stages. SARGEANT STRIPES hung wide while setting pace to mid stretch, went gamely under pressure in a solid effort. F F REYHER FLYER stalked leaders along inside, responded to move nearest leader mid stretch, weakened in late going. SUNNY SERENADE trailed early while along inside, improved position in lane. STORMY OLIVER failed to menace. FLYINGSOFREE dueled on the outside of rivals for half, gave way. LAST OF THE SHIFTY forwardly positioned outside foes for half, gave way. DAHZI failed to menace. DENVER SAM was outrun.
