MR. SHOCK AND AWE allowed to settle for half, moved up smartly along inside into stretch, responded to steady urging, got up in time. VIA RODEO dueled from outset, responded to gain narrow edge at the half, held clear advantage into stretch, went gamely under pressure but unable to hold off rush of winner. PATHBREAKING was never far back along inside, moved nearest leader mid stretch, tired. STRIDE well back after half, improved position. SUCH A DEAL stalked leaders from start, came six wide into lane, lacked response when asked in drive. ROYAL BRASS was never a factor. HELLO MO came seven wide from middle of pack when making bid into stretch, flattened out. CUVEX never threatened. BOILER BOB wide from outset, outrun. PIRATE'S JOURNEY hustled to front, dueled for half, faded. SPLENDID HIGH chased pace for half, dropped back. EL PAJARETE was never close.
