SEEPLE BELL pressed pace, vied 1/4, wore down foe, up final strides. STOP DIGGING prompted 4-wide, bid stretch, fought gamely, just missed. CRAFTY DAME forwardly placed 5-wide, rallied stretch, closed willingly. HADES' HALO void early speed, closed well late. SWISS SARAH forced pace, tired, weakened. MARY MAE set pressured pace, tired, gave way. SHELLIE ROAD mid pack, lacked late response. BINDI slow early, mild late rally. DARETOBEDIFFERENT off slow, failed to threaten. ALIHI EXPRESS showed little, dull effort. HURRICANE CHEYANN brief bid early, no factor. LANG'S GLORY outrun, no threat.
