DANCE TO THE STAR allowed to settle for half, circled leaving far turn, five wide into lane, responded to handling and got up in time. HOMERUN KING sent to front, set pace with clear advantage to mid stretch, responded to pressure in drive but unable to hold off late rush of winner. MAJOR BILLY within striking distance throughout, lacked the needed late kick in late going. CURLYS DAY stalked leaders from outset, raced three wide into lane, weakened in late going. THE BUDDY PLAN chased pace along inside into stretch, tired. CONCORDES SAINT well back at the half, raced six wide into stretch, failed to menace. WICKED FLYER was never a serious threat. ONE BOUNCE CHECK was outrun. MEJO MASAMUNE dueled into gap after break, back to paddock.
