BOILER BOB raced in middle of along inside from outset, rallied while between foes in late going, got up in time. PIRATE'S JOURNEY within striking distance outside rivals from outset, responded to handling in drive but outfinished in a game effort. AUNT RITA'S TOMCAT sent to front, set pace to late going, went gamely under pressure but couldn't last. DINNER CHOICE well back after a half, finished with a solid belated rail rally. HELLO MO well back after a half, came five wide, finished with a solid belated mid track rally. WHO FIRED FRED forwardly positioned along inside, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, tired. AMERICAN MEMORIES failed to menace. ROKOCOKO was not a factor. THE PRINCE AND I hung wide, never threatened. PREDICTION chased early pace, faded steadily after half. ROYAL OKIE was always outrun.
