**Footnotes**

LUCKY TRUCKEE hustled to front soon after start, set pace with clear advantage into stretch, went unchallenged, ridden out to wire. QUITE A LINE was never far back along rail, moved up to be nearest leader mid stretch, no match for winner but clearly best of others. SNUFFY WHO chased leader along rail into stretch, had no rally in drive. SECONDTIMEISBETTER was never far back wide of rivals, five wide into stretch when making bid, flattened out in drive. K D RANSOM came six wide from middle of pack into lane, failed to menace. GOLD'S UP raced in middle of pack along inside, not a factor. FIRST TIME CALLER stalked leaders while on the outside from start, came four wide into stretch, gave way. GRAY MATTERS along inside, never threatened. WERRABRAVECYCLONE raced along inside, lacked response when asked. STORM STROLLER showed little. J. R. RULER was always outrun. RIVER STORM was never close.
