Footnotes

HIDDEN VAN was never far back outside rivals, came five wide when making bid into stretch, responded handling to take over and draw clear in late going. TWAIN (IRE) within striking distance along inside from outset, came four wide into stretch when making bid, loomed danger mid stretch, flattened out. PATHBREAKING dueled from outset, responded to gain narrow edge along rail at the half, went gamely into stretch, tired in drive. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE well back after a half along inside, three wide into stretch, finished with a solid belated rally. INTERMISSION chased leaders into stretch, gave way. ROYAL BRASS failed to menace. SILVERBELLA was never a factor. MINNESOTA SLEW well positioned outside rivals for half, lacked response when asked. EDLO'S BOUNCE never threatened. BRITE MANEUVERS wide of rivals from outset, showed little. FACE OF FORTUNE was always outrun. HELLO MO was never close, dropped back steady in lane, vanned off after the running in apparent distress.
