E F FIVE broke alertly to front, opened clear advantage into stretch, kept to task during drive and remained clear to wire. TOCCING MAN stalked leader throughout, unable to reach winner during stretch run but clearly best of others. BLASTITARY within striking distance into stretch, had no rally. VICAR'S ROCK STAR raced in middle of pack, lacked response when asked. OLIVERS SONG wide from outset, failed to menace. CASH THE DEPOSIT was not a factor. HUNKAVICAR chased early pace, faded after half. HANGMAN'S GULCH was never a threat. DRB'S CRYSTAL BALL was outrun. PINCHRUNNER was never close.
