DANCE TO THE STAR allowed to settle early, circled leaving far turn, came six wide into lane, responded to steady urging throughout stretch drive, got up in time. MAJOR BIG TIME within striking distance outside foes from outset, responded to gain slight nod mid stretch, went gamely but unable to hold off rush of winner. WICKED FLYER moved up to take early advantage, dueled for lead to stretch, went gamely under pressure in drive before weakening late. HOMERUN KING dueled along rail from start, responded to gain nod at the half, went gamely in drive before tiring late. ONE BOUNCE CHECK raced in middle of pack along inside for half, failed to menace. CLASSIC ATTITUDE well back for half, improved position in lane. CURLYS DAY was never a factor. HAXTUN'S ACE vied with early leaders, faded steadily after quarter mile. MEJO MASAMUNE hung wide, never threatened. HUNKASLEW was outrun.
