TREACHEROUS trekked four wide through opening turn, tucked behind front runners down the backstretch, and rallied in stretch for the score. BIRDIEBOBTOO was unable to match strides with eventual winner in the stretch. HUNTERWOOD POINT closed the gap on the leaders after rating well back at the half. MR. PADRE dictated the pace from outset and through opening half before being outfinished. BORN FORCE put forth an even effort from a mid pack position. TULSA TE settled in a comfortable position and advanced placing through the far turn. SUNDAY SLICK chased throughout. MAGICAL TWIST passed tiring foes. SILVANUS tired in the late going after making a brief bid. GOLD PEG failed to factor from a trailing position. SHOTGUN WILLY saved ground and tired.
