SHOW ME THE GLITZ was outkicked in final strides by eventual winner after being well placed in opening half. FARMER'S LEGEND was unhustled in early stages and was gaining in the late stages after a wide final turn to improve position. BOLD LAUNCHER weakened in late stages after dueling in the opening half. SUMSUMSUMMERTIME showed an even effort. TAOS RIDGE lacked a needed late rally after a wide trip. ZAVATA JR. steadily faded. PRECEPTS TEN faltered late after setting pace in opening half. LITTLE TRAVIS tired late after giving chase from mid pack in opening half.
