CITY VOW allowed to settle in stride, came off rail into stretch three wide, responded to steady while racing mid track, got up in final strides. COMIC FOOL hustled to front, rated well on short lead into stretch, responded to pressure throughout long drive only to be outfinished on the wire. PERFECT STRIKE chased leaders from outset, responded to challenge leader mid stretch, went gamely to wire giving way grudgingly in final stages. CALL ON CARSON within striking distance along inside throughout, responded belatedly between rivals. T W HAMMERIN HANK was never far back racing outside rivals, had no rally. STREAK OF LIGHT within striking distance into stretch, lacked response. THAT TIGER chased leader for half, gave way. HOMERUN KING was not a factor. LEWPTEDO trailed throughout.
