EXPEDITIOUSLY broke sharply from rail, gained command early and never relished. MR. BARMAN rushed from outset to remain in striking position of eventual winner, took the two to three path through the turn and was unable to run down winner in final furlong. TEANCUM was unable to muster a late rally after saving ground from outset. CHARMING A. J. lacked a response in closing strides following a two to three path trip. SAND AND SAGE saved ground to no avail after hopping at the break. MR SHANE THE PAIN was never involved. ROYALTY IN EXCESS lacked a late rally after angling out at top of stretch to improve position. SHOWTIMES SUNDAY saved ground to no avail. TY'S HONOUR failed to menace. SPLICER trailed throughout.
