BRAHMS HAZE within striking distance outside rivals from start, responded to strong handling when asked into stretch, gained narrow edge mid stretch, then was all out to prevail in the end. BIG MISSION broke sharply to the front, set pace into stretch, responded to pressure during stretch run and just failed to last in final stages. TAKEITTOHEBANK was never far back, finished with a solid belated rally to gain the show spot. SINGIN VICAR well back after three quarter, finished with a solid inside rally but too late. FOLSOM chased pace for three quarters, tired in drive. EDLOS TWIST along inside, failed to menace. THE LATEST TWIST raced in middle of pack for half, not a factor. WIDE CLYDE raced in mid pack, never a threat. COWBOY JOE in back from outset, showed little. CALL ME MR. CASH stalked pace into stretch, faded. EDLO'S BOUNCE was always outrun.
