PURRFECT ALIBI led at each call pole and was outfinished. DANNY TEMPLETON (IRE) was well placed and gave a mild early bid before lacking a late rally. THREE SPOOLS contested for early lead and weakened in the late stages. HARLOW ROAD travelled mid pack and had nothing in the late stages. DASHER DAWN trailed throughout. HARLEY MOONIN steadily faded. RAZOR CUT was pulled up in apparent distress soon after start and was vanned off; did not cross finish.
