Footnotes

KING GULCH rated well for the opening half in the second flight, angled to the three path in tandem with CANAL GRANDE and THE LATEST TWIST to challenge for top spot, prevailed in stretch duel. REGAL JOURNEY set the pace from a two path stance, unable to fend off winner in stretch. CANAL GRANDE angled out to a four wide pose to challenge in the far turn, outfinished. WILDCAT ENERGY lacked a closing kick to end a two path trip. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE improved placing with late interest. GORDO AT WAR raced evenly from a reserved pose. THE LATEST TWIST trekked widest of all through far turn, weakened in stretch. NO DOUBLE DIPPEN failed to factor from a back rated stance. RED PIRATE found an inside route down the backstretch, made a charge along rail nearing the half pole, used up in late stages. NO YIELDING steadily faded.
