WOOD BE LAWYER kept to task along the inside for the score while being challenged by multiple rivals in the late stages. BRAHMS INFERNO contended from outset and attended the pace throughout but was unable to match strides with the eventual winner. HAXTUN'S HUSTLER entered the far turn as the outer most of five rivals and was outfinished in final furlong. AWESOME WONDERER vied between rivals and led in the far turn before being outfinished and coming up empty. CLURMOR gave chase and passed tiring foes in the final portion of contest. SUCH A DEAL failed to threaten from a trailing pose. CALL TRANSFER failed to menace. ROYAL BRASS rushed to contend, was used up, and tired. BONK through early.
