STAR COURT chased pace from outset, responded to gain command into stretch, kept to task in drive, remained well clear to wire. GOLDEN STREET rated off pace, moved up to be nearest pace mid stretch, no match for winner in drive and settled for second best. EDLO'S BOUNCE allowed to settle for half, finished with a mild mid track rally to gain show spot. CALL TRANSFER raced outside rivals, failed to menace. KYLES OLIVER hustled to front, faded steadily after half. MAGICNCOURT was never a factor. SLEWS TRIUMPH never threatened. S H S SAND STORM showed little. JAKEDONTKNOW dueled for lead from outset, hustled to a clear lead at the half, dropped back steadily into stretch, eased in lane, crossed finish.
