TIGERTUDE was rated off early pace, came four wide into stretch, responded to handling to gain command and draw off in late going. TOPPER'S MOVIN' broke to front, opened clear advantage into stretch, went gamely under pressure but no match late for winner, held unto second spot. STITCHIT stalked leaders from outset, moved up to be nearest leader mid stretch, flattened out. WRONG SPELL raced outside of rivals in back for half, failed to menace. PRINCESS HAILEY saved ground from outset, moved up to be nearest leader at the half, gave way in lane. JANN'S PASSAGE was not a factor. EARN THIS was never a threat. LITTLE BROWN WOLF was always outrun. PUNCH PASSAGE vied with early leaders, faded steadily in lane.
