FLEET CONTINENTAL vied between rivals into and through the turn, kept to task, and inched away in final sixteenth. LEE CREEK saved ground through the turn, split foes at the three sixteenths pole and earned second while finishing willingly. KID RAMBO trekked four wide through the turn, attended pace, and held on for show. PURL'S GRAY EGO finished with best stride late to advance placing after trailing the field early. BURGENDLAND weakened after attending pace for opening half. ONE MORE WEEK travelled as the widest of five through the turn and tired in final furlong. ALERT THE PRESS steadily faded.
