Footnotes

JIMNI assumed a striking pose along rail in the second flight through the first bend and down the backstretch before gaining command at top of stretch and winning the stretch duel. MANSIONES secured terms with rival to set pace early from just off rail, maintained position exiting final bend and was nipped in the stretch duel by eventual winner. SPEED KING settled from outset behind both flights of rivals before finding room along rail to advance position and gain a piece with a late charge. CURLYS DAY secured a position along the rail in the second flight early and swung outward to advance position but lacked a late rally to improve position. DASHING RED was three wide through the first turn before settling in the backstretch three deep and lacking a response to urging in the final strides. FAVORITE TWIST trekked through the first bend between rivals and steadily faded in the latter half of race. SHOW ME THE GLITZ gained position on the early pace from along rail and weakened thereafter.
