MANOVAN from outset was three deep to help set pace and prevailed in the stretch duel to get the score. METALLIC MIST secured the rail to set pace in opening half but relished command at top of stretch and was unable to come again. SWISS RECORD was well placed in a striking position just behind pacesetters and off rail into and through the bend before rallying mildly to gain a piece of share. CELTIC SUNDAY gained terms from between foes early and was outfinished in crucial portion of contest. PALTU tracked the leaders from just out of striking range while a bit off the inside racing to the turn but came up empty when called upon entering the upper stretch. CATCH MY TALE trailed the field early and swung wide entering the stretch but never seriously menaced. EDLOS TWIST was urged to dispute pace along backstretch to no avail and gave way from mid turn to finish.
