Footnotes

EDLOS TWIST chased leader from outset, took over entering stretch, kept to task and remained clear to wire. K B CONWELL stalked leaders from start, came four wide into lane, moved up to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out. HOMERUN KING was never far back along inside, moved up mid stretch to loom threat, faltered. FLYINGSOFREE stalked leaders into stretch, gave way. FOLSOM came five wide from off pace into lane, not a factor in drive. COWBOY JOE was never a threat. PEAVYS TIME was always outrun. GRAND OLE PARTY was never close. COWBOY HOY hustled to front, dropped back steadily after half.
