HEAD WAITER was away alertly to attend pacesetter and was three wide through the bend before extending out and holding off the late charge of NOAH BY STORM. NOAH BY STORM settled three deep behind the pacesetter into the turn, was asked to respond mid turn, split foes and finished very strong to earn place. HOT FIRE gained a position on the fore and was between foes through the bend before being outfinished by top pair. CLASS FAVORITE gave chase from three wide and in the second flight through the turn but lacked a needed rally in the final furlong. TOCKING MAN had a wide trip and improved position in the crucial stages. SUNNY SERENADE gave chase and lacked response mid track in the final furlong. GRAND OLE PARTY trailed the field from outset and rallied mildly in the latter portion of contest. HAVASU PARTY gave chase from between foes from a pose just out of striking range before tiring in the final furlong. COLORADO MAN saved ground to no avail. MAXIMUM TWIST showed little and never was able to gain contention. COWBOY HOY was eager for early lead and steadily weakened thereafter.
