### Footnotes

BEHOLD DE BUY rated off early pace, circled rivals leaving far turn, came eight wide into lane, moved willingly when asked, took over while being ridden out in late going. R SKYDIVER well back for half, circled seven wide into stretch when making bid, responded well to loom danger mid stretch, flattened out in late going. RIVRAV dueled while racing between foes from outset, responded to gain narrow edge mid stretch, went gamely before weakening in late going. WALLY VAN stalked leaders from outset, raced six wide into stretch, had no rally. FOREST MOUSE well back for half, moved up belatedly along inside. VERNY dueled while racing between foes into stretch, went gamely to mid stretch, gave way. CATABOUT hung wide while forwardly positioned for half, not a factor during stretch run. HERE I AM SEND ME hustled to front along rail, went gamely to mid stretch, faded. SIR FOX failed to menace. LUCKY OPPORTUNITY was never a threat. MILE HIGH MOJO was outrun. ALERT THE PRESS dueled on the outside of rivals for half, dropped back steadily in lane.
