TOP TOP dueled wide early, took a short pressured lead three-wide on the turn, opened up into the stretch, drew out. USAIN dueled three-wide between horses early, forced the pace from the two-path between horses on the turn, was no match for the winner in the drive. PLATINUM HUNTER, fractious in the gate, dumped his rider, returned to the paddock for a new jockey, stalked the forced pace wide on the turn, took the show. SUPER SALESMAN dueled between horses early, forced the pace inside on the turn, tired in the stretch. KERZNER advanced mildly inside. DEMAND TO KNOW stalked outside, lacked a rally. BANG ON THE MONEY dueled inside early, remained well placed inside back of the forced pace on the turn, faded. DIAMOND STORM stalked wide, lacked a rally. WEGGS PURSER stalked off the rail, faded.
