CRAFTY BUT TRUE, wide early, moved inside on the turn, rallied willingly off the rail to get by late outside. GOING FOR A FEW stalked the duel inside early, remained well placed inside on the turn, took over in early stretch, opened up, couldn't hold on late with a good try. MASON DIXON LINE dueled inside, opened up into the turn, gave way in early stretch. TODAY'S STAR stalked off the rail, gained mildly. STORMY PRICE dueled outside early, dropped back into the turn, lacked a rally. DOUBLE CLUTCH showed little outside. MAC Q showed little.
