MOMENT OF SONG had wide speed, moved to force the issue outside through the turn and into the stretch, opened up passing the eighth pole, drew out. ASCARI saved ground, finished well outside. CHILOSO opened up inside early, had outside pressure through the turn, gave way passing the eighth pole. MT. CHARLES stalked the forced pace off the rail through the turn, lacked the needed rally. SWIM AGAIN, well placed inside, finished evenly. SID THE KID raced evenly back and off the rail. ACTION CALL stalked between horses, faded on the turn. PAGER showed little wide. OLD INDIAN TRICK chased outside early, off the rail on the turn, faded.
