PIVOT PAD had inside speed under pressure, opened up in early stretch, drifted out, held well. HIGH TONED, wide early, advanced inside in late turn, rallied to take the place. HE IS forced the pace outside, was turned back into the stretch. ADORCI stalked the forced pace off the rail, made a place bid in the drive. ANOTATION stalked the forced pace inside, made a place bid in the drive. MONEY BARON saved ground. KENTUCKY THUMBS UP stalked the forced pace wide, tired. THE SUPPLY PROGRAM showed little.
