Footnotes

JAMESON TOPS tracked the leader off the rail, challenged three-wide between horses in mid turn, dueled into the stretch, found more late to prevail. ADDITIONAL EXPENSE tracked the leader outside, moved to force the issue four-wide in mid turn, dueled outside to deep stretch, couldn't match the winner late. BEEN THERE BUDDY tracked the leader inside, advanced to force the issue from the two-path between horses in mid turn, made an inside bid to mid stretch, tired. HELLO SCOTT stalked off the rail, rallied evenly. TOCCER broke off balance, trailed to the stretch, finished best of the rest. SUGAR FIX broke off balance, saved ground. EXCESS OF CLASS, wide early, stalked outside, showed little. THREE MILE TOUGH opened up early, had increasing outside pressure through the turn, gave way in late turn.
