**Footnotes**

DOUBLE TRICKSTER stalked wide early, advanced outside back of bid battle on the turn, rallied outside. PRETTY PURSUIT stalked the forced pace inside, rallied to be up late for the place. DIRECT TO HOWDY dueled inside, opened up into the stretch, tired late. THINK FIRST dueled between horses early, forced the issue outside through the turn, gave way into the stretch. R U DIGGIN IT passed a tired rival. SKIPPERS JOY forced the pace three-wide early, well placed outside into the turn, faded.
