MARKET JITTERS tracked the leader from the outside, came with a long drive to steadily gain on DOUBLE CLUTCH in the drive, wore that rival down late. DOUBLE CLUTCH opened up early, took a clear lead into the stretch, gave his best when challenged after mid stretch, couldn't hold late. CAESAR'S MONKEY, wide early, stalked outside, finished evenly. BAM LOOK AT THAT, well placed inside, lacked a rally. FARM HAND broke slow, back early, passed a tired rival. TIZZYS DESERT STAR, between horses early, stalked off the rail, faded.
