E HARNER, wide early, forced the issue outside through the turn, dueled into the stretch, drew out from mid stretch. KEY LARGO trailed to the stretch, finished well outside. BONDSTEEL advanced inside, took a short lead on the turn, dueled into the stretch, gave way in mid stretch. FROZEN ASSETS saved ground, rallied belatedly. BUNGEE JUMPER pressed between horses, stalked the forced pace off the rail on the turn, lacked the needed closing response. ST. BLAINE'S QUILL pressed outside early, remained well placed off the rail on the turn, faded. SILVER WILDCAT stalked off the rail, faded. SIMPLE INTENTIONS opened up early, gave way into the turn, steadied inside in late turn.
