MS BARB WIRE stalked the forced pace off the rail, steadied inside when lacking running room on the turn, rallied between horses to be just up. TONGUE AND GROOVE stalked outside, finished well, missed. VALENTINE CANDI forced the pace outside, dueled into the stretch, shook her pace rival in mid stretch, missed. TOWN SCANDAL had early speed inside, stalked the duel off the rail on the turn, made a bid to late stretch. BEARSLITTLEWHISPER, back early, advanced inside in late turn, moved outside in mid stretch, rallied belatedly outside. COLLEEN'S JACKPOT stalked the forced pace off the early, took short lead inside on the turn, dueled into the stretch, gave way in mid stretch. UNITE TONITE stalked between horses, lacked the needed closing response. CHARLSIES GIRL had early speed off the rail under pressure, stalked the duel inside on the turn, faded. COIN AGAIN pressed wide, faded in the stretch.
