FURIOUS GEORGE opened up early, took a good lead into the stretch, was kept to ask to hold safe. MONEY BARON stalked outside, came over after passing the eighth pole and shut off SUB DUE FORCE while moving to the inside during his rally, finished well up the rail. ROUGH N' ROWDY tracked the leader inside, gave his best in the stretch. TARTUGA ISLAND tracked the leader off the rail, gave his best in the stretch. TRICK OR BLUFF tracked the leader outside, gave his best in the stretch. SUB DUE FORCE stalked between horses, was shut off after passing eighth pole, steadied, finished evenly. PULLEDMEOUT passed a tired rival. COWBOY AT HEART, well placed off the rail, faded on the turn. The jockey aboard SUB DUE FORCE, and the trainer, lodged a claim of foul against the rider of MONEY BARON for interference in the stretch. MONEY BARON was subsequently disqualified from second place and placed sixth.
