MIDNIGHT CRUISER advanced to press widest, dueled outside into the stretch, took a short lead passing the eighth pole, drew out after passing the sixteenth pole. BRIDGE AND TUNNEL stalked off the rail, finished well outside. COWGIRL'S GRIT, well placed outside, forced the issue between horses through the turn, dueled into the stretch, gave way passing the sixteenth pole. HALO'S RING had speed off the rail under inside pressure, took the inside under pressure on the turn, dueled into the stretch, gave way passing the sixteenth pole. NAUGHTY DOTTY forced the pace inside, dropped back before mid turn, remained well placed inside back of the bid battle into the stretch, faded. LASTING CASH stalked wide, lacked a rally. DIAMOND CONTENDER stalked widest, lacked a rally.
