FOLLOW UP, always well placed outside, stalked a bid battle through the turn, rallied outside to get by late. STEAM THAT KETTLE opened up early, had outside pressure after a quarter, shook her pace rival into the stretch, was pressured from the inside by EASTERS LILY, gave her best to hold that one off, couldn't match the winner late. VALID WORD saved ground, finished well between horses. EASTERS LILY stalked the forced pace inside, made a rail bid in the stretch, was in tight late, . NEEDLESTICK advanced to force the pace outside after quarter, gave way into the stretch. ROX AND ROLLS, back early, passed tired rivals. MIDNITE FEVER showed little outside. ON WILD GROUND saved ground, faded. The rider aboard EASTERS LILY lodged a claim of foul against the rider of STEAM THAT KETTLE for interference in the stretch. STEAM THAT KETTLE was disqualified from second and placed fourth.
