SMARTY FAWCETT stalked off the rail, advanced back of the forced pace on the final turn, challenged outside into the stretch, drew out from mid stretch. THOMAS BAINES advanced to force the pace outside, took a short lead on the final turn, shook his inside pace rival for good passing the eighth pole, couldn't stay with the winner. LUCAVA stalked the forced pace inside, held the show. SPRING BLUES stalked wide, lacked a rally. PULGARCITO stalked between horses, dropped back on the backstretch, re-advanced between horses on the final turn, finished evenly. OUR BOY KEN opened up early, had outside pressure down the backstretch, gave way late on the final turn, stayed close to the eighth pole. DADDY'S VISION stalked outside, faded.
