THE PHENOM opened a short clear lead early, had outside pressure in late turn, dueled, held off WILD PARTY in a long drive. The latter, well placed off the rail, challenged into the stretch, gave his best to the wire. ECTON'S GEM trailed to the stretch, finished well outside. HESABIGCAT saved ground, well placed off the rail on the turn, gained mildly. OOPS AND A HALF well placed inside, stalked a duel into the stretch, tired. MR. INSTIGATOR, well placed between horses early, dropped back inside on the turn, faded. TAKEHOME ASOUVENIR, wide early, outside into the turn, faded between horses.
