SILKEN MANNER opened up early, was never pressured, held well in the stretch. CRAFTY BUT TRUE, back between horses early, advanced outside, rallied. WINSTON WOLF tracked the winner off the rail, couldn't gain in the stretch, tired. BORRACHITO, wide early, well placed outside on the turn, tired in the drive. WHEREVER IT'S BEST saved ground, steadied in early stretch, finished evenly. HELLO SCOTT well placed outside early, inside in late turn, faded. G. H. GLEASON, well placed inside into the turn, faded. FERRY INN showed little. MCCART took a bad step early and was eased.
