PATRIOTIC GENERAL dueled inside, exchanged bumps with TIGHT END while continuing to duel with that one through the stretch, found more late to prevail. TIGHT END dueled outside, exchanged bumps through the stretch, gave way late. JUSTCALLMETATER, wide early, stalked the duel off the rail on the turn, rallied outside. GOTATIGERBYTHETAILED stalked the duel inside, rallied between horses. VALLEY STATION stalked wide, outside on the turn, gained mildly. CRAFTY BUT TRUE broke slow, well placed between horses early, faded inside. TODAY'S STAR passed a tired rival. UNCLE LLOYD stalked the duel between horses early, faded. The rider aboard TIGHT END lodged a claim of foul against the rider of PATRIOTIC GENERAL for interference in the stretch drive. There was no change.
