I'MNOTEASYIMACINCH stalked the forced pace off the rail, challenged outside in late turn, opened up into the stretch, held well. PULLEDMEOUT stalked wide, advanced on the final turn to challenge, couldn't gain on the winner. SORRY saved ground, advanced into switch along the rail late on the final turn, checked, waited to the stretch, rallied between horses. HERATS MISSILE trailed early, advanced off the rail, lacked the needed rally. TRICK OR BLUFF stalked the forced pace inside, lacked a rally. CADEAUX DU MONDE (GB) forced the pace inside, shook his pace rival late on the final turn, gave way to the winner into the stretch. RICHARD'SDOINGTIME had outside speed under pressure, gave way after passing the midpoint of the final turn.
