EASTERS LILY tracked the leader inside, too a short lead between horses into the final turn, took the inside under pressure, shook her bid rival into the stretch, opened up, held well. I SWEAR stalked outside, forced the issue into the final turn, was turned back into the stretch, held the place. MISS TWINZAK saved ground, gave her best in the stretch. DA HEAT checked nearing the first turn, trailed to the final turn, advanced off the rail. BRIDAL VISION stalked outside, finished evenly. NO IMAGE stalked between horses early, inside into the final turn, made a mild outside bid into the stretch. SPEEDUBAI opened up early, had outside pressure from mid backstretch, gave way into the final turn.
