MASON DIXON LINE had inside speed under pressure, opened a short clear lead after a quarter, was challenged into the stretch, held off DOUBLE CLUTCH to his outside in the drive, just held on late. WANDO'S APPEAL stalked inside, rallied up the rail, just missed. DOUBLE CLUTCH pressed outside, came with stretch long bid, was turned back late. HELLO SCOTT advanced wide on the backstretch, well placed off the rail on the turn, gained mildly. CAESAR'S MONKEY stalked between horses, rallied belatedly. SEEKINGACAREER stalked between horses, inside in late turn, lacked the needed rally. ORVILLE GOT EVEN stalked wide, tired. PURSUIT OF VICTORY showed little.
