CAFE AU MEY pressed outside, opened up midway through the final turn, took a good lead into the stretch, missed. QUEEN TINA stalked the pressured pace between horses, improved her position. EXHILARATED trailed to the stretch, rallied belatedly. BOUND TO THRILL stalked the pressured pace inside, faded in the stretch. DASH N DANCER stalked the pressured pace outside, faded. ROMANCED passed a tired rival. TEMPERAZE opened up early, had outside pressure on the backstretch, gave way midway through the final turn.
