THE COLONELS CAT stalked outside, rallied to take over passing the sixteenth pole, drew out. SNAPPY CHAPPY pressed outside, challenged into the stretch, took over passing the eighth pole, gave his best before giving way. LILY'S KNIGHT, back early, advanced wide, rallied. MISTER MOONEY tracked the leader inside, finished evenly. BATTLE DESIGN stalked wide, rallied belatedly. WRIGLEYVILLE stalked wide, rallied belatedly. BAM LOOK AT THAT stalked off the rail, lacked a rally. THREE MILE TOUGH took a short clear lead early, opened up on the turn, was challenged into the stretch, gave way passing the eighth pole. THRILLOFTHEFIGHT, well placed inside early, faded. TIZZYS DESERT STAR saved ground, lacked a rally. MR. NOMER showed little back between horses. SCHMATZ showed little.
