E HARNER stalked wide, rallied wide, took over late, drew out. SMARTY MATT stalked back between horses, finished well off the rail to take the place. NOT OPPOSED had inside speed under pressure, opened up into the stretch, tired late. CANCERBERO saved ground, lacked the needed rally. LEES DYNA MAN pressed three-wide, tired in the stretch. J C'S ACTION forced the pace outside, gave way into the stretch.
