CATMANTOO stalked the forced pace off the rail, challenged outside after passing the eighth pole, dueled, drew out late. THE SUPPLY PROGRAM stalked outside, gave his best in the stretch. CROWNED ROYAL, back early, advanced off the rail, finished well outside. E HARNER forced the pace outside, made an outside bid into the stretch, dueled, shook his pace rival in mid stretch, had little left for the ralliers late. T DRIVE had inside speed under pressure, dueled into the stretch, gave way in mid stretch. COAL SMUDGE, back early, advanced mildly wide. MUDCHUTE stalked outside early, well placed inside on the final turn, faded. RAGE TILL DAWN passed tired rivals. RAISE THE HEAT, well placed off the rail early, inside on the final turn, tired in the drive. SHADY ROYALE, well placed inside early, faded.
