SCHILLERTHEKILLER, back early, made a good move outside on the turn, challenged into the stretch, dueled, drew out from the sixteenth pole, had something left at the wire. U R BURNIN DAYLITE had outside speed under pressure, forced the issue through the turn, was turned back into the stretch, kept coming to take the place. MUTED WORD forced the pace inside early, maintained a short lead on the turn, shook his pace rivals into the stretch, was taken on by the winner, dueled, gave way passing the sixteenth pole. ASK EDDY, back early, advanced inside on the turn, rallied mildly outside. PIERRE LAPIN stalked the forced pace off the rail, tired in the stretch. MR EXSPEEDIENT stalked the forced pace outside early, dropped back on the turn. PURE GLORY forced the pace between horses, dropped back in late turn, faded.
